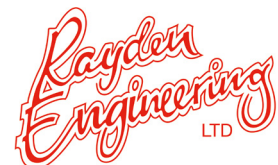
If you ask any prominent figure in the pipeline industry to name networking event of the year, the answer is clear: the Pipeline Industry Guild Annual Dinner.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

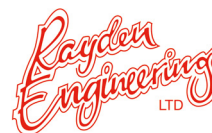
